

JAMES G. FAUSETT SERVICE TO THE PROFESSION AWARD**Eligibility**

The AIA Atlanta Award for Service is in honor of a firm, group or individual for outstanding service to the Chapter, Institute, or profession at large. Individual nominees do not have to be AIA members. Multiple awards may be given out in a single year.

Criteria

Candidates will be evaluated on how well they meet the program criteria as established by the Board, which include:

- The nominee's contributions and commitments to the Chapter, state or local components, the Institute and/or profession (NOMA, AFGA, etc.).
- The reason(s) for the recognition should have occurred in the preceding 36 months.

Submission

Nominations in this category may be made by AIA members, AIA staff, AIA Atlanta Patrons, or AIA Atlanta Committee Chairpersons. The Honor Awards Committee will make final determinations on those that receive this recognition – and there can be up to three (3) recipients of this award in a given year. Each nomination should highlight the Candidate's achievements and contributions and shall contain the following, in PDF format:

- A nomination letter from an AIA member, NOMA/ADC/AFGA board member, or AIA staff that summarizes the contributions made, not to exceed two pages
- The nominee's resume/CV, in either standard or narrative form. Note, do not submit the nominee's design portfolio, but rather one that demonstrates the diversity of the nominee's activities. Note that this item only applies to individual nominees, not to programs or other organizations.
- At least one (and no more than three) additional reference letter(s) that highlight the candidate's contributions to the profession.
- Optional supporting documentation/images, not to exceed 5 pages

Chapter members currently serving on the AIA Atlanta Board of Directors are ineligible for the James Fausett Service to the Profession Award.
